CHEAT SHEET

ParsePort TextSearch for Note taggging

By using specific symbols, the engine will understand the exact place, text and information that needs to be tagged.

Symbol	Meaning
*	WILDCARD. If used by itself, means everything within the selected Area tag will be tagged. If used in a search string like e.g. "can*of" in "You can search for a lot of text", the result will be "can search for a lot of"
<	BEFORE a given phrase. If used in a search string like e.g. "You can* <of "you="" a="" be="" can="" for="" in="" lot="" lot"<="" of="" result="" search="" text",="" th="" the="" will=""></of>
<<	ONE LINE BEFORE . Same as above, but previous row before a given text. If you add more "<" signs, you can increase the number of rows to stop at before a phrase.
>	AFTER a given phrase. If used in a search string like e.g. "You can>*text" in "You can search for a lot of text", the result will be "search for a lot of text"
>>	ONE LINE AFTER. Same as above, but next row after a given phrase. If you add more ">" signs, you can increase the number of rows to search for after a phrase.
